Municipality of Bajardo (Im) – Italy


In this small medieval village, situated in the *Liguria Region* close to the sea, at 1000 m over sea level and destined to the abandonment, a recovery plan has been presented, planned and executed by the local cooperative society. This plan rests on the three pillars of SD:

Netherlands + Italy + Malta + France + Latvia + Romania + Bulgaria + Lithuania



First Pillar

Building and restoration of the medieval village, using technologies of **bio architecture** for tourist and residential purposes (borgo hotel) and design of a new residential area;



Second Pillar

Use of new technologies in the field of sustainable resources, aiming at the achievement of a voltaic system that will make a village **completely energy independent**;


